An action group was set up to fight a proposal to close the Llanidloes War Memorial hospital. Brecon and Radnor Community Health council (CHC) had warned in October 2005 that hospitals in Llanidloes, Bronllys, near Brecon, and Builth Wells could possibly be affected by the Health Boards deficit of £6.7 million pounds. In September 2006 the chief executive of Powys Local Health Board, Andy Williams, revealed plans to close the hospital. From the medical fraternity Chris Overton, and Dr Steven Leslie addressed the campagners. Politicians who also addressed the campaigners were Lembit Opik MP. Mick Bates AM, and David Thomas, Plaid Cymru.




I took several photographs of the campaigners, and these are just two of them. Margot Jones, in the yellow T shirt was a very active leader of the campaign.
