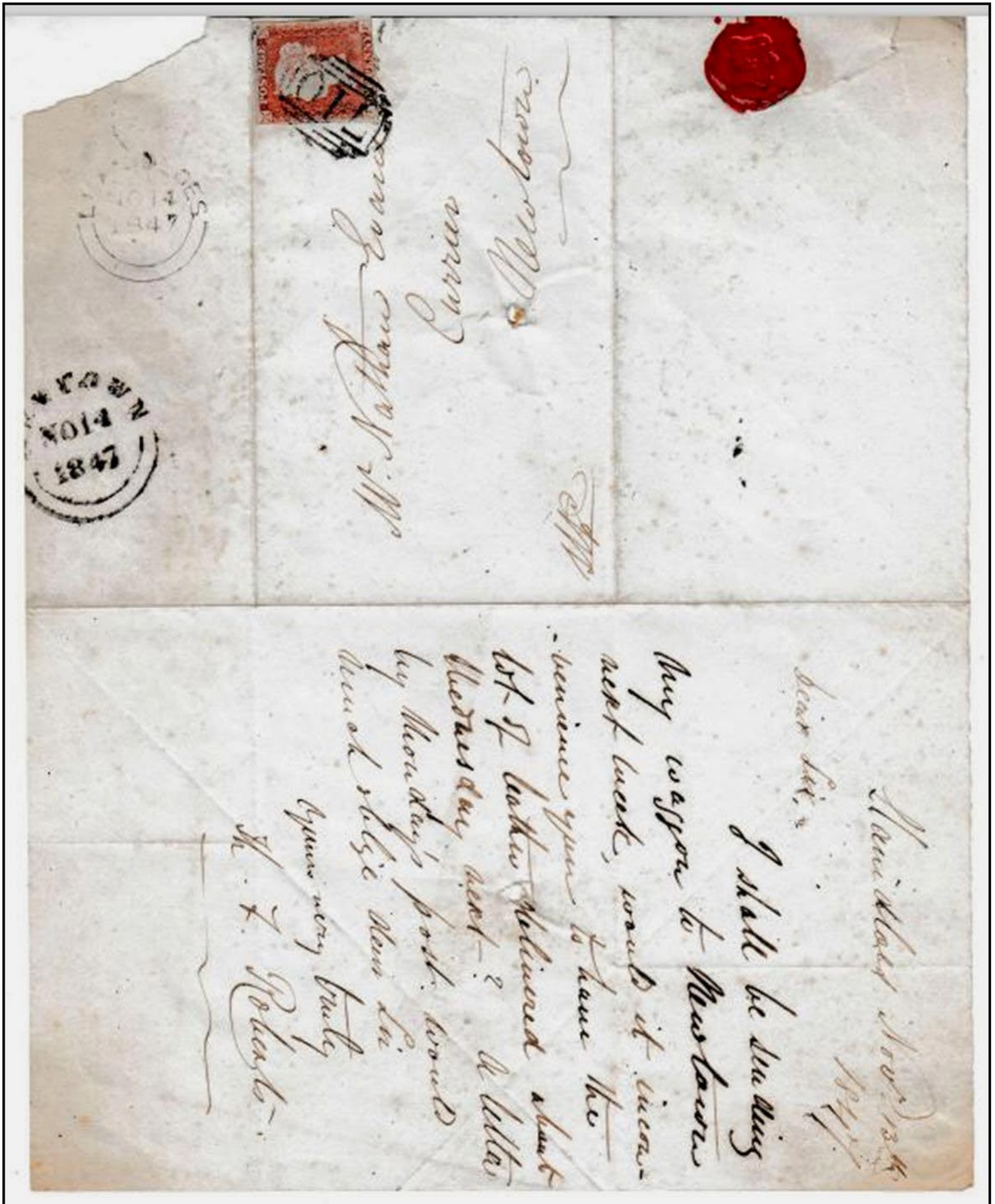


A Llanidloes carriers letter
