## Machin definitive stamps. Pre-decimal.

These definitive stamps are quite difficult to collect for two reasons. They were produced in many colours, and also with several varieties of phosphor banding. They were in circulation a long time ago, between 1967 and 1869, so it is quite difficult to find some of the earlier ones, except from specialist dealers.



This is how I store my definitives Mounted on printed card in A5 clear pockets, and in a sturdy loose leaf file. There are many blank spaces which will take a long time to fill.
